During the month of March, MVPD responded/handled a total of 6,259 calls/incidents. 4,710 House Watch checks were conducted. 777 traffic stops were initiated with 794 citations being issued for 1344 violations. (Note: 21 Assists in Hedwig, 152 in Houston, 7 in Spring Valley and 0 in Hillshire)

Personnel Changes/Issues/Updates

- Dispatcher Jeffery return to duty from maternity leave. We are fully staffed.
- Ms. Jennifer Sachs completed a review of a citizen complaint filed with the department.

Major/Significant Events

- There were 2 burglaries of habitations this month. Both occurred while the residents were home. The first burglary occurred on 3/16/24 in Bunker Hill Village. Detectives were working on that Saturday and at the time of the event. They responded within 3 minutes. A suspect was located through the combined use of both a city and a privately owned ALPR. MVPD detectives are working in conjunction with HPD on the identified suspect in hope of obtaining an arrest warrant. The second burglary occurred on 3/21/24 in Hunters Creek. The suspects fled from the home entering the old Las Alamedas site. Detectives were on duty and also responded within minutes. The investigation is pending results of latent fingerprints that were recovered from the scene.
- On 3/24/24 while patrolling Chapelwood Church Officer Nick Harwood's police vehicle was struck by another car in the parking lot. The new Dodge Charger with 2000 miles suffered damage to the rear quarter panel. The insurance company for the driver responsible for the accident is paying for repairs to the MVPD vehicle.

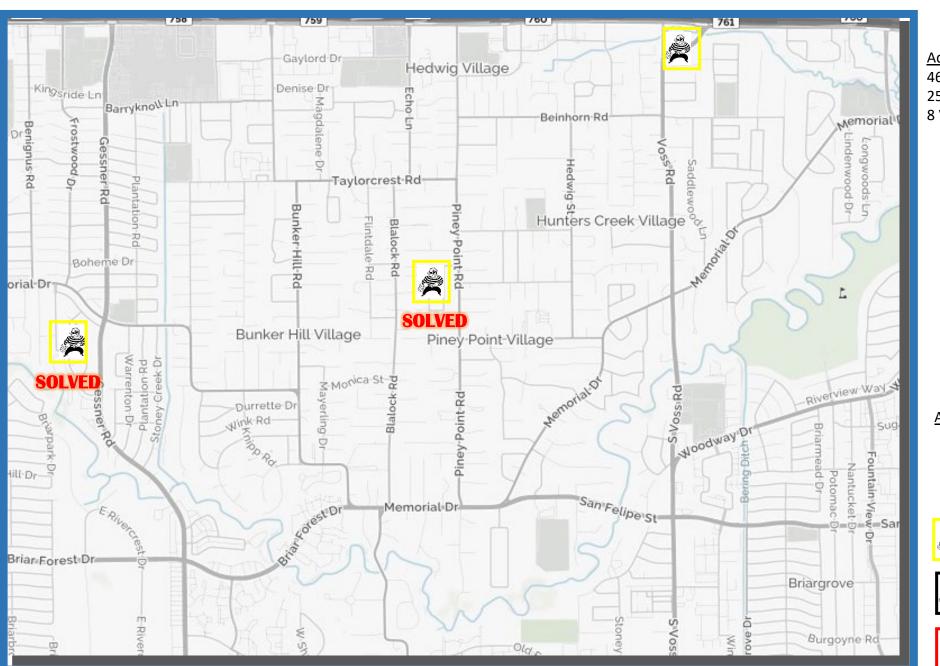
• Work has started on the 2024 CIP HVAC replacement project.

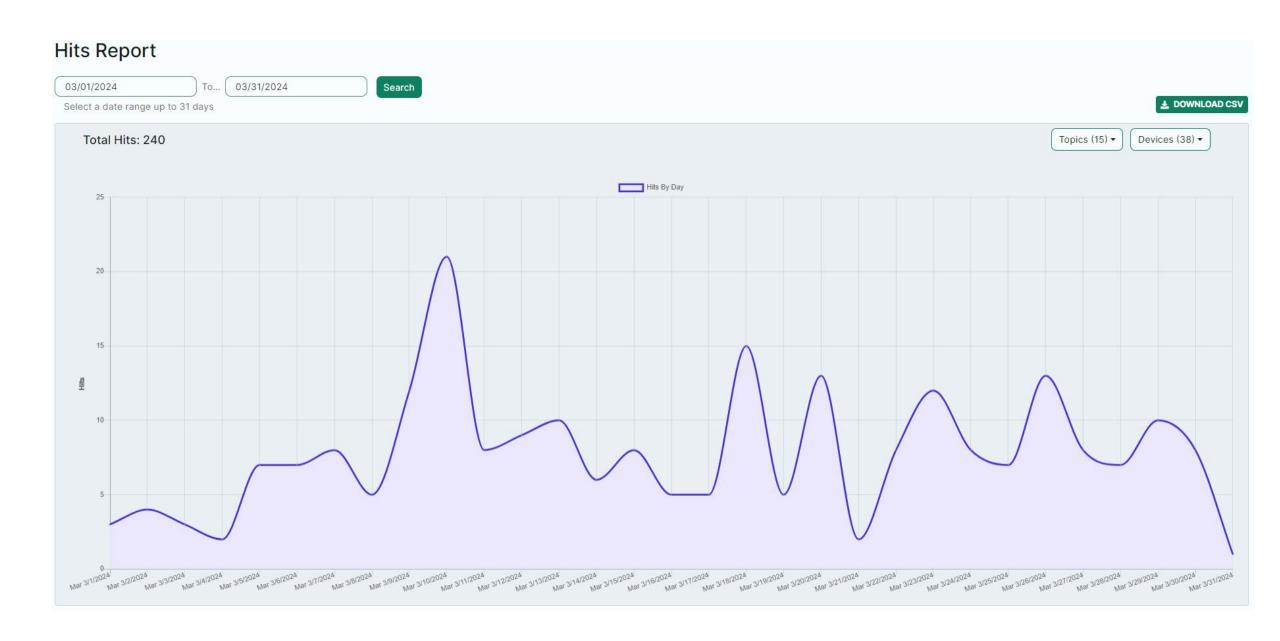

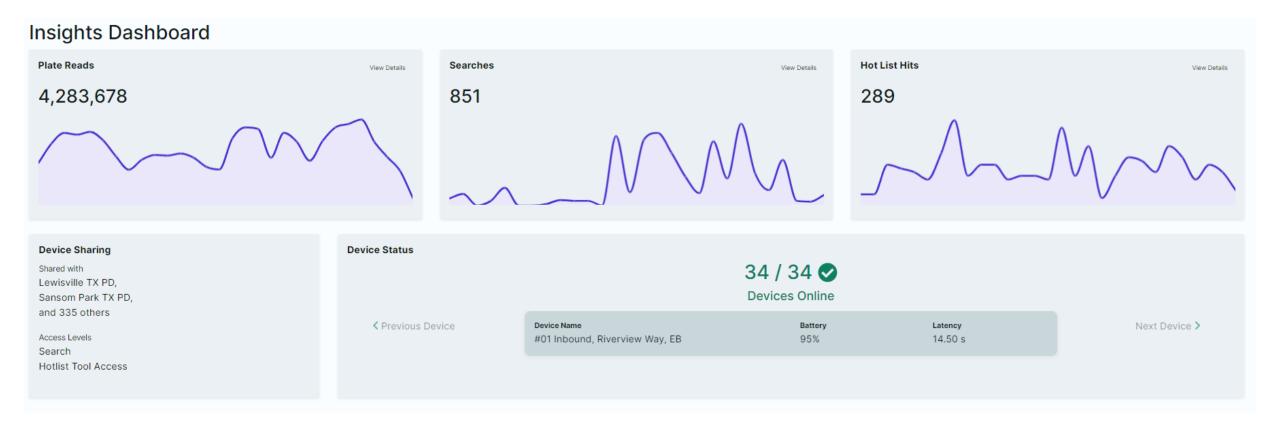

Executive Summary

With the increased use of electric bicycles and electric riding toys, (e-bikes) on city streets and sidewalks, the lack of current regulation, and safety concerns, all three Villages (Piney Point, Hunter's Creek and Bunker Hill) provided direction to the Memorial Village Police Department (MVPD) to review and draft a recommended ordinance on how best to regulate the use of e-bikes within the Villages.

The proposed amendment classifies e-bikes based on their motor type and speed as follows:

- <u>Class 1</u>: Equipped with motor that assists the rider only when the rider is pedaling and with a top assisted speed of 20 MPH or less.
- <u>Class 2</u>: Equipped with a motor that may be used to propel the bicycle without the pedaling of the rider and with a top assisted speed of 20 MPH or less.
- <u>Class 3</u>: Equipped with a motor that assists the rider only when the rider is pedaling and with a top assisted speed of more than 20 but less than 28 MPH.

The proposed ordinance amends Chapter 9 of the Code of Ordinances:

- Section 9-1 Definitions
- Section 9-9 Operation of motor driven vehicles on public sidewalks and public hike and bike paths
- Section 9-10 Small Motored Vehicles Restricted
- Adds Section 9-133 Electric Riding Toys General Provisions
- Adds Section 9-134 Electric Bicycles Bicycle Paths
- Adds Section 9-135 Electric Bicycles Class 3 Electric Bicycles

- Adds Section 9-136 Electric Bicycles Age Restrictions
- Adds Section 9-137 Electric Bicycles Operation at Night
- Adds Section 9-138 Electric Scooters and Electric Skateboards
- Adds Section 9-139 Electric Riding Toys Penalty

Amending the code will clarify where and under what circumstances the three classifications of e-bikes are permitted in or upon public spaces. The amendment intends to minimize conflicts between operators of e-bikes and pedestrians by reducing the potential impacts of e-bikes in these spaces. Additionally, the amendment ensures the compatibility of the use of e-bikes with other passive recreational activities, while protecting the safety of all users of the City's sidewalks and streets.

The amendments were drafted and reviewed by the City Attorney.

Recommended Action

Staff recommends that City Council discuss and take any desired action.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BUNKER HILL VILLAGE, TEXAS AMENDING SECTION 9-1, DEFINITIONS, OF ARTICLE I, IN GENERAL TO UPDATE LANGUAGE; AMENDING SECTION 9-9, OPERATION OF MOTOR DRIVEN VEHICLES ON PUBLIC SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC HIKE AND BIKE PATHS PROHIBITED, OF ARTICLE I, IN GENERAL, TO ADD ALLOWANCE FOR ELECTRIC BICYCLES; ADDING SECTION 9-10, SMALL MOTORED VEHICLES RESTRICTED, OF ARTICLE I, IN GENERAL, TO RESTRICT SMALL MOTOR VEHICLES FROM PUBLIC SIDEWALKS; ADDING SECTION 9-133, ELECTRIC RIDING TOYS -GENERAL PROVISIONS, SECTION 9-134, ELECTRIC BICYCLES -BICYCLE PATHS, SECTION 9-135, ELECTRIC BICYCLES - CLASS 3 ELECTRIC BICYCLES, SECTION 9-136, ELECTRIC BICYCLES -ELECTRIC BICYCLE AGE RESTRICTIONS, SECTION 9-137, ELECTRIC BICYCLES - OPERATION AT NIGHT, SECTION 9-138, ELECTRIC SCOOTERS AND ELECTRIC SKATEBOARDS, SECTION ELECTRIC RIDING TOYS - PENALTY OF ARTICLE V, BICYCLES, OF CHAPTER 9, MOTOR VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BUNKER HILL VILLAGE UPDATING AND AMENDING RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATED TO ELECTRIC **BICYCLES INCLUDING GENERAL DEFINITIONS** AND **AND** GUIDELINES FOR USE OF ELECTRIC RIDING TOYS; AMENDING ARTICLE V, BICYCLES, TO READ ARTICLE V, BICYCLES AND ELECTRONIC RIDING TOYS OF CHAPTER 9, MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BUNKER HILL VILLAGE TO ADD RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATED TO ELECTRONIC SCOOTERS AND SKATEBOARDS; PROVIDING FOR PENALTY; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

* * * * * *

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bunker Hill Village, Texas finds that the use of electric riding toys and small motor vehicles on public sidewalks causes a risk of injury for operators, pedestrians and bicycle operators; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bunker Hill Village, Texas finds that Section 9-1, Definitions, of Article I, In General, of Chapter 9, Motor Vehicle and Traffic, of The Code of Ordinances of The City should be amended to include definitions of small electric riding toys and small motor vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bunker Hill Village, Texas finds that Section 9-10, Small Motored Vehicles Restricted, should be added to the City's Code of Ordinances to regulate small motored vehicles in public spaces; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bunker Hill Village, Texas finds that the following sections should be added to the City's Code of Ordinances to regulate the use of small electric riding toys: section 9-133, Electric Riding Toys - General Provisions, Section 9-134, Electric Bicycles - Bicycle Paths, Section 9-135, Electric Bicycles - Class 3 Electric Bicycles, Section 9-136, Electric Bicycles - Electric Bicycle Age Restrictions, Section 9-137, Electric Bicycles - Operation At Night, Section 9-138, Electric Scooters And Electric Skateboards, Section 9-139, Electric Riding Toys - Penalty Of Article V, Bicycles, of Chapter 9, Motor Vehicle And Traffic.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bunker Hill Village, Texas hereby finds that it is the purpose of this Ordinance to update the Code to promote the public health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the City and to minimize public and private injury and losses due to electric riding toys and small motor vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUNKER HILL VILLAGE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct.

SECTION 2. Section 9-1, Definitions, Chapter 9, Motor Vehicles and Traffic of the City's Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding thereto the language underscored below:

"Sec. 9-1. - Definitions.

Class 1 electric bicycle means an electric bicycle equipped with a motor that assists the rider only when the rider is pedaling and with a top assisted speed of 20 miles per hour or less.

Class 2 electric bicycle means an electric bicycle equipped with a motor that may be used to propel the bicycle without the pedaling of the rider and with a top assisted speed of 20 miles per hour or less.

Class 3 electric bicycle means an electric bicycle equipped with a motor that assists the rider only when the rider is pedaling and with a top assisted speed of more than twenty (20) but less than twenty-eight (28) miles per hour (MPH).

Electric bicycle means a bicycle equipped with fully operable pedals and an electric motor of fewer than 750 watts and with a top assisted speed of twenty-eight (28) miles per hour or less.

<u>Electric scooter</u> means a scooter assisted by an electrical source or battery that allows for self-propulsion of three (3) miles per hour (MPH) or greater.

<u>Electric skateboard</u> means a skateboard assisted by an electrical source or battery that allows for self-propulsion of three (3) miles per hour (MPH) or greater.

Electric riding toys means any electric bike. electric skateboard, and / or electric scooter.

Moped means a motor vehicle that is equipped with a rider's saddle and designed to have when propelled not more than three wheels on the ground, that cannot attain a speed in one mile of more than 30 miles per hour, and the engine of which (1) cannot produce more than five-brake horsepower: and (2) if an internal combustion engine, has a piston displacement of 50 cubic centimeters or less and connects to a power drive system that does not require the operator to shift gears.

Motor-assisted Scooter means a self-propelled device with (1) at least two wheels in contract with the ground during operation: (2) a braking system capable of stopping the device under typical operating conditions: (3) a gas or electric motor not exceeding 40 cubic centimeters: (4) a deck designed to allow a person to stand or sit while operating the device; and (5) the ability to be propelled by human power alone.

Pocket bike or minimotorbike means a self-propelled vehicle that is equipped with an electric motor or internal combustion engine having a piston displacement of less than 50 cubic centimeters. is designed to propel itself with not more than two wheels in contact with the ground, has a seat or saddle for the use of the operator. is not designed for use on a highway, and is ineligible for a certificate of title under Chapter 501, Texas Transportation Code.

<u>Top assisted speed</u> means the speed at which the bicycle's motor ceases propelling the bicycle or assisting the rider.

<u>State Law Reference</u> - Standard for Electric Bicycles. Texas Transportation Code Sec. 664.001.

<u>State Law Reference</u> - Standard for Motor-assisted scooter and pocket bike, <u>Texas Transportation Code Chapter 551"</u>

SECTION 3. Section 9-9, Operation of motor driven vehicles on public sidewalks and public hike and bike paths prohibited, of Article I, In General, of Chapter 9, Motor Vehicles and Traffic of the City's Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding the language as indicated by underscore below:

"Sec. 9-9. - Operation of Motor Driven Vehicle on Public Sidewalks and Public Hike and Bike Paths Prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor driven or motor propelled vehicle or conveyance of any kind upon any public sidewalk or public hike and bike path within the city unless,

- (a) such vehicle is designed as an accommodation for a person with a physical disability and is being utilized by such person for its intended purpose; or
- (b) such vehicle is an Electric Riding Toy that is expressly permitted to operate on a sidewalk under the provisions of this Code of Ordinances."

SECTION 4. Article I, In General, of Chapter 9, Motor Vehicles and Traffic of the City's Code of Ordinance is hereby amended by adding a new section, Section 9-10, Small Motored Vehicles Restricted by adding the language as indicated by underscore below:

"Sec. 9-10. - Small Motored Vehicles Restricted; Penalty

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a moped or motor-assisted scooter upon any public sidewalk or public hike and bike path within the city.
- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a pocket bike or mini motorbike upon any public sidewalk. public hike path, public bike path, highway, road, or street within the
- (c) Any person who shall violate this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and. upon conviction. shall be fined an amount not to exceed \$2,000."

SECTION 5. Article V, Bicycles, of Chapter 9, Motor Vehicles and Traffic of the City's Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as indicated in the language underscored below:

"ARTICLE V. - BICYCLES AND ELECTRIC RIDING TOYS"

SECTION 6. Article V, Bicycles, of Chapter 9, Motor Vehicles and Traffic of the City's Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding thereto new sections Section, 9-133, Electric Riding Toys - General Provisions, Section 9-134, Electric Bicycles - Bicycle Paths, Section 9-135, Electric Bicycles - Class 3 Electric Bicycles, Section 9-136, Electric Bicycle - Age Restrictions, Section 9-137, Electric Bicycles - Operation at Night, Section 9-138, Electric Scooters and Skateboards, and Section 9-139, Electric Riding Toys - Penalty, as indicated in the language underscored below:

"Sec. 9-133. Electric Riding Toys - General Provisions

- (a) Operators and/or Riders of any Electric Riding Toy operating on a sidewalk where permissible by City Ordinance shall slow and yield to any vehicle exiting a driveway.
- (b) Operators and/or Riders of any Electric Riding Toy operating on a sidewalk where permissible by City Ordinance shall yield and, if necessary, stop when crossing any street or roadway.
- (c) Chapter 551 of the Texas Transportation Code. as amended. shall apply to the extent it does not conflict with City Ordinance.

Sec. 9-134. Electric Bicycles - Bicycle Paths

(a) Wherever a useable public path for bicycles has been provided adjacent to a public street, Class 1 and Class 2 electric bicycle riders may use such path.

- (b) When operating on a sidewalk, Class 1 and Class 2 electric bicycle riders shall not exceed five (5) miles per hour.
- (c) Class 1 and Class 2 electric bicycle riders shall yield and provide right-of-way to pedestrians, slow to no more than three (3) miles per hour and pass no closer than three (3) feet of while passing pedestrians. and clearly announce presence before overtaking a pedestrian. The pedestrian shall have the right-of-way.
- (d) Class 3 electric bicycles shall not be used on bicycle paths but shall use the public street and shall comply with all applicable traffic ordinances.

Sec. 9-135. Electric Bicycles - Class 3 electric bicycles

Class 3 electric bicycle riders shall ride as near as practicable to the right curb or edge of the road way, unless:

- (a) the person is passing another vehicle moving in the same direction: or
- (b) the person is preparing to turn left at an intersection or onto a private road or driveway: or
- (c) a condition on or of the roadway. including a fixed or moving object, parked or moving vehicle, pedestrian, animal or surface hazard prevents the person from safely riding next to the right curb or edge of the roadway.

Sec. 9-136. Electric Bicycles-age restrictions

- (a) All riders of Class 1 and 2 electric bicycles under the age of seventeen (17) shall wear a helmet. All riders of Class 3 electric bicycles under the age of twenty-one (21) shall wear a helmet.
- (b) Class 1 and Class 2 electric bicycle riders under the age of twelve (12) shall be accompanied by an adult when on a public space.
- (c) Class 3 electric bicycle riders shall be fifteen (15) or older to ride the electric bicycle on public space."

Sec. 9-137. Electric Bicycles - Operation at Night

All electric bicycles operated at night on a public street. path or sidewalk shall be upfitted with lights and reflectors as required by Chapter 551 of the Texas Transportation Code, as amended.

Sec. 9-138. Electric Scooters and Electric Skateboards

(a) Electric Scooters and Electric Skateboards shall be ridden on sidewalks

where sidewalks are available.

(b) Electric Scooters and Electric Skateboard riders shall yield to any pedestrian or bicycle when passing or overtaking on sidewalks. Pedestrians have the right of way.

Sec. 9-139. Electric Riding Toys -Penalty

- (a) A first violation of this ordinance may result in the violators being required to complete an electric riding toy safety class conducted by the Memorial Villages Police Department.
- (b) First violation of this ordinance may be subject to a fine not to exceed \$50.
- (c) Subsequent or repeat violations of this ordinance may be subject to a fine not to exceed \$2,000.
- (d) A parent or guardian of a minor. who knowingly allowed said minor to violate this ordinance and said minor is found in violation of this ordinance. may be subject to a fine not to exceed \$2,000."

<u>SECTION 7.</u> Any person who shall intentionally, knowingly, recklessly, or with criminal negligence violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine in an amount not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for any violation hereof, with each day of violation constituting a separate violation.

SECTION 8. In the event any clause phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent or ordinances jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and, the City Council declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts.

SECTION 9. The amendment to the Code of Ordinances, City of Bunker Hill Village, Texas provided for in this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the date of its execution below.

Executive Summary

On March 6, 2024, CenterPoint filed an application with the Public Utilities Commission (PUC), as well as with cities seeking to increase system-wide transmission and distribution base rates by \$60 million per year. CenterPoint asks the City to approve an increase of \$17 million in retail transmission and distribution rates (an increase of about 1%) and \$43 million in wholesale transmission rates (an increase of about 6.6%). According to CenterPoint, the impact on an average residential customer would be an increase of about \$1.25 per month.

Bunker Hill Village participates in the Gulf Coast Coalition of Cities (GCCC), a coalition of similarly situated cities served by CenterPoint that have joined together to efficiently and cost-effectively review and respond to issues affecting rates charged in the CenterPoint's service area. The GCCC legal counsel and the City Attorney recommend all cities act on the request as outlined in the proposed resolution.

The proposed resolution suspends the effective date of the Company's rate increase for the maximum period permitted by law to allow the City, working in conjunction with other members of GCCC served by CenterPoint to evaluate the filing, determine whether the filing complies with law, and if lawful, to determine what further strategy, including settlement, to pursue.

The City was not aware that this notice was sent out last month as it was not received. Despite the April 10 deadline, the GCCC legal team was notified and requested that the City still proceed with formal action, and they would notify CenterPoint on behalf of the City.

Recommended Action

WHEREAS, on or about March 6, 2024, CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC ("CenterPoint" or "Company"), pursuant to PURA §§ 33.001 and 36.001 filed with the City of Bunker Hill Village, Texas ("City") a Statement of Intent to change electric delivery rates in all municipalities exercising original jurisdiction within its service area, effective April 10, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the City is a member of the Gulf Coast Coalition of Cities ("GCCC") and will cooperate with the other similarly situated city members and other city participants in conducting a review of the Company's application and to hire and direct legal counsel and consultants to prepare a common response and to negotiate with the Company and direct any necessary litigation; and

WHEREAS, GCCC's member cities have previously authorized intervention in electric utility rate case proceedings before the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Commission"); and

WHEREAS, GCCC has previously authorized the hiring of the law firm of Lloyd Gosselink and consultants to negotiate with the Company, to make recommendations regarding reasonable rates, and to direct any necessary administrative proceedings or court litigation associated with an appeal of a rate ordinance and the rate case filed with the City or the Commission; and

WHEREAS, PURA § 36.108 grants local regulatory authorities the right to suspend the effective date of proposed rate changes for ninety (90) days after the date the rate change would otherwise be effective; and

WHEREAS, PURA § 33.023 provides that costs incurred by cities in ratemaking activities are to be reimbursed by the regulated utility.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUNKER HILL VILLAGE, TEXAS:

- 1. That the April 10, 2024, effective date of the rate request submitted by CenterPoint on or about March 6, 2024, be suspended for the maximum period allowed by law to permit adequate time to review the proposed changes and to establish reasonable rates.
- 2. That the City is authorized to cooperate with GCCC to coordinate efforts to protect the interests of the City and protect the interests of CenterPoint's end-use customers residing and conducting business within municipal limits.
- 3. That the City's reasonable rate case expenses shall be reimbursed by CenterPoint on a timely basis.
- 4. That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution is passed is open to the public as required by law and the public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required.
- 5. The City of Bunker Hill Village holds its election on the first Saturday in May of each year. The election for Councilmember Positions 1, 2, and 3 are held in even-numbered years, and the election for Mayor and Councilmember Positions 4 and 5 are held in odd-numbered years.

At the January 2024 meeting, City Council approved Ordinance No. 24-617, calling for the May 4, 2024 General Election. The final date to file as a candidate for one of the three positions was Friday, February 16, 2024, at 5:00 p.m. The incumbents filed for their respective positions with no opposition.

The candidates are as follows:

Councilmember Position No. 1 – Eric Thode

Councilmember Position No. 2 – Susan B. Schwartz

Councilmember Position No. 3 – Carl Moerer

Texas Election Code, Section 2.053, authorizes City Council to declare unopposed candidates elected to office and to cancel the election for the applicable unopposed offices.

Staff recommended Council approve Ordinance No. 24-623 to declare the unopposed candidates for Councilmember Positions 1, 2, and 3, as elected and cancel the General Election scheduled for May 4, 2024.

A motion was made by Councilmember Brown and seconded by Councilmember Rosenbaum to approve Ordinance No. 24-624 to cancel the General Election scheduled for May 4, 2024.

The motion carried 5-0

X. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE A SIX-MONTH CONTRACT EXTENSION WITH YARDWORKS, INC. FOR LANDSCAPE SERVICES INCLUDING RIGHT-OF-WAY MAINTENANCE, ESPLANADES, CITY HALL, AND MEMORIAL VILLAGES POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE TIME PERIOD OF MARCH 31, 2024 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2024 – Gerardo Barrera, City Administrator

At the February 2021 meeting, City Council awarded a contract to Yardworks, Inc. for landscaping and maintenance services for the contract period beginning April 1, 2021, and

ending March 31, 2023. The contract provides the option for two one-year extensions. The first extension was approved by Council for the period of March 31, 2023, to April 1, 2024.

The contract maintains six areas based on specific landscape and maintenance services:

- Area 1 Landscaped Esplanades at Strey, Briar Forest, and Bunker Hill Rd
- Area 2 Irrigated Esplanades and Trails
- Area 3 City Facilities (City Hall, MVPD, and Water Well sites)
- Area 4 Seasonal Plantings and Associated Maintenance
- Area 5 Hike and Bike Trails and City Rights-of-Way (not irrigated)
- Area 6 Ditch Right of Way Maintenance

Concerns regarding service quality in all landscaping areas have been raised throughout the year. In response, staff requested Council feedback and direction at the February 2024 meeting regarding whether to extend the contract for an additional year or solicit formal bids for landscaping services. Council directed staff to extend the contract for a six-month period and subsequently evaluate the quality of work at that time. This evaluation will determine whether to continue with the contract or initiate a formal bidding process for landscaping and maintenance services.

Staff have met with Yardworks to review the contract and to ensure that the services provided align with the City's expectations.

Funding for this contract is shared between the General, Utility, and Metro Funds.

Staff recommended Council approve a six-month contract extension covering the period of March 31, 2024, to September 20, 2024, with Yardworks, Inc. for landscape and maintenance services.

A motion was made by Councilmember Rosenbaum and seconded by Councilmember Brown to approve a six-month contract extension with Yardworks, Inc. for landscape and maintenance services.

The motion carried 5-0

XI. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BUNKER HILL VILLAGE, TEXAS, AND RPS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$196,600.00 FOR THE DESIGN OF ASPHALT MILL AND OVERLAY IMPROVEMENTS FOR KNIPP ROAD, STREY LANE, TAYLORCREST ROAD, AND BUNKER HILL ROAD – Gerardo Barrera, City Administrator

The City's Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) includes the asphalt and overlay of Knipp Rd, Strey Ln, Taylorcrest Rd, and Bunker Hill Rd. This project was originally scheduled to begin in 2023, however, due to lack of preliminary engineering, it was delayed to 2024.

In October 2023, Council approved a contract with RPS, the City's Street and Drainage Engineer, to complete a geotechnical study that evaluated core samples to analyze the soil stabilization, road base, and current thickness of asphalt of the streets listed. The

geotechnical report yielded the necessary information to prepare for the design phase of this project.

Staff requested and received a proposal from RPS for design services that include, but are not limited to; project management coordination, bid phase services, public outreach, limited construction phase services, and construction materials testing.

All design work is expected to be completed within three (3) months from receipt of the Notice to Proceed.

Per Local Government Code 252.022, professional services are exempt from formal bids.

A motion was made by Councilmember Thode and seconded by Councilmember Brown to approve a contract between the City of Bunker Hill Village, Texas and RPS in the amount of \$196,600.00 for the design of asphalt mill and overlay improvements on Kipp Rd., Strey Ln., Taylocrest Rd., and Bunker Hill Rd.

The motion carried 5-0

XII. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH TEXAS PRIDE DISPOSAL – Gerardo Barrera, City Administrator

The City's solid waste collection contractor, Texas Pride, proposed an amendment to the original contract. The amendment reflects the implementation of a Variable Energy Charge/fuel recovery fee to address changes in fuel costs. Texas Pride was able to hedge fuel pricing for previous years, however the hedge expired in early 2024.

The proposed charge will only be assessed to bills when the monthly average price per gallon of diesel fuel reaches or exceeds \$3.25 per gallon. The charge will be calculated as follows:

\$ 3.25	1%
\$ 3.50	2%
\$ 3.75	3%
\$ 4.00	4%
\$ 4.25	5%
\$ 4.50	6%
\$ 4.75	7%
\$ 5.00	8%

- 1% if the monthly average fuel price equals \$3.25 per gallon plus 1% for every \$0.25 increase that the monthly average fuel price is over \$3.25 per gallon
- The percentage increase is capped at 8%

The U.S. Department of Energy for Petroleum and Other Liquids for the Gulf Coast (PADD 3) will be used as the index for fuel pricing.

This fee will be absorbed by the City and is not expected to increase the cost of resident's trash bill.

Council directed staff to determine the index price on the date the contract was originally executed and present the information at a later date. The intent is to use this information to re-negotiate if needed. Council was not in favor of index pricing.

A motion was made by Councilmember Rosenbaum and seconded by Councilmember Moerer to table this item.

The motion carried 4-1

XIII. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE A FINAL PLAT FOR 9 VALLEY FORGE AS RECOMMENDED BY THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION – Elvin Hernandez, Director of Public Works

During the plan review of a new home at 9 Valley Forge, it was found that no final plat was recorded with Harris County. The property does not qualify for a short-term final plat as the property is on a private street and not within an existing public street circulation.

At the February 2024 Planning and Zoning Commission meeting, the Commission approved the final plat and recommended it be taken to City Council for approval. Staff and the City's consultant have reviewed the final plat and find that it meets all requirements of the City's ordinances.

A motion was made by Councilmember Schwartz and seconded by Councilmember Thode to approve a final plat for 9 Valley Forge as recommended by the Planning and Zoning Commission.

The motion carried 5-0

XIV. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE THE FOLLOWING PAYMENTS THAT EXCEED \$50,000:

At the November 2023 meeting, Council directed staff to remove expenditures exceeding \$50,000 from the consent agenda and present them as separate line item(s) on the regular agenda for consideration and possible action.

The City has received one invoice that meets this requirement:

A. Ram Rod Utilities, LLC, Invoice No. 181 in the amount of \$53,200.00 for wastewater emergency repair work completed on the Memorial/Chatam trunk line in January 2024.

A motion was made by Councilmember Rosenbaum and seconded by Councilmember Brown to approve payments that exceed \$50,000.

The motion carried 5-0

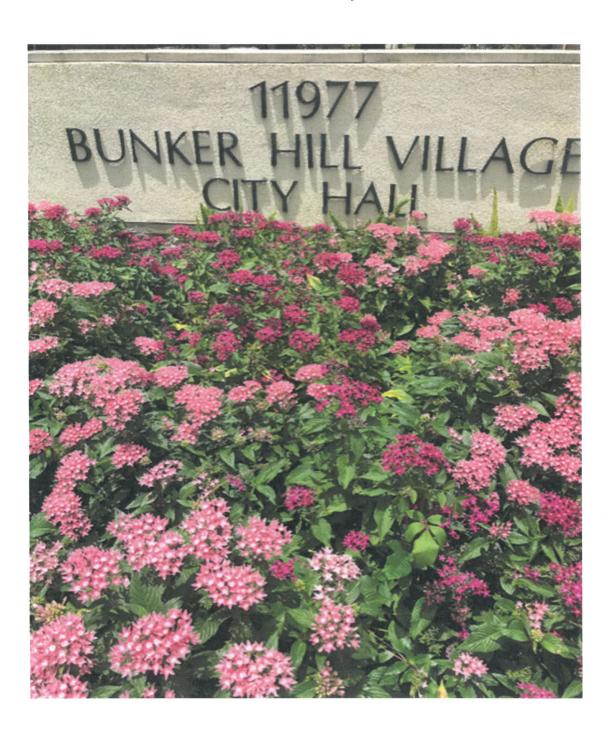
