II. DISCUSSION REGARDING THE PROPOSED FY 2015 BUDGET

Karen Glynn, the City Administrator, presented the 2015 Proposed Budget. The highlights of the budget was the recommendation to keep the tax rate flat at \$0.297855, to adequately fund reserves for infrastructure replacement and management.

Karen Glynn recommended a rate increase for water and wastewater to adequately fund reserves to add utility lines to the city's replacement fund and infrastructure management.

III. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO PROPOSE AN AD VALREM TAX RATE OF \$0.297855 FOR 2014 TAX YEAR.

Motion was made by Councilman Janecek and seconded by Councilwoman Rosenbaum to move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of .297855 which is effectively a 11.41% increase in the tax rate. Motion carried 5-0.

Council agreed to have the first public hearing on September 16, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. and the second public hearing at 8:00 a.m. on September 23, 2014. The final meeting to adopt the tax rate would be September 30, 2014 at 8:00 a.m.

IV. ADJOURN

Motion was made by Councilman Brown and seconded by Councilman Glover to adjourn the meeting at 1:13 p.m. Motion carried 4-0.
