<u>Schedule</u>

- CHECK-IN TIME: Parade staging begins at 8:45 a.m. in the Memorial Church of Christ (MCOC) parking lot facing Gaylord. Please arrive no later than 9:30 a.m.
 You will be assigned a parade color (zone) at check-in for line-up.
- **START TIME:** Parade begins promptly at 10:00 a.m. MVPD Fun Run & Bike Ride begins at 9:45 a.m.
- **PARADE ROUTE:** Parade will start at MCOC at Gaylord and Echo Ln., continue east on Gaylord to Piney Point Rd., then turn south on Piney Point Rd. and conclude in front of Ecclesia.

Participant Rules and Guidelines

- All entries must be family-friendly and decorated to fit a patriotic theme.
- Candy/favors may be distributed to the crowd along the route.
- Playing music with vulgar lyrics and/ or profanity is not allowed.
- No jumping between floats or on/ off moving vehicles once the parade begins.
- Keep one (1) car length distance between you and the entry in front of you. No weaving or swerving is allowed.
- Smoking and the use and/ or possession of alcohol and firearms are prohibited during the parade at all times. This is a family-friendly holiday event; all participants shall conduct themselves in a courteous and respectful manner. Any signage shall also be courteous and respectful.
